Safety Manual

WARNING - PRESSURE WASHER SAFETY

Any piece of equipment can be dangerous if not operated properly. YOU are responsible for the safe operation of this equipment. The operator must carefully read and follow any warnings, safety signs and instructions provided with or located on the equipment. Do not remove, defeat, deface, or render inoperable any of the safety devices or warnings on this equipment. **IF** any safety devices or warnings have been removed, defeated, defaced, or rendered inoperable, **DO NOT USE THIS EQUIPMENT!!!**

HIGH PRESSURE SPRAY CAN CAUSE EXTREMELY SERIOUS INJURY. THE PRESSURE STREAM CAN PIERCE SKIN, DAMAGE EYES, BURST EAR DRUMS. USE EXTREME CAUTION.

NEVER TOUCH A LEAKING HOSE, IT CAN PIERCE SKIN. SHUT THE UNIT DOWN BEFORE HANDLING IT.

Use extreme caution whenever operating, moving, loading, or unloading this equipment.

Provide adequate ventilation when operating this equipment.

Caution:

1. Do not allow pump to run without water.
2. Protect the unit from freezing.

Safety Checklist

Follow these tips to ensure pressure washer operation safety.

1. Always read the warning labels on the equipment, and operating instructions.
2. Always turn off the unit when making adjustments, such as changing the nozzle or adding accessories.
3. Pressure washers have a number of inherent warnings, including:
 - a. Keep water spray away from electric wiring or fatal shock may result.
4. Exercise care when using this equipment
5. Do not put hands or fingers in front of high pressure nozzle.

6. Never allow children or unauthorized personnel to handle washer.
7. Wear proper attire: waterproof cover-alls, heavy rubber shoes, safety glasses and insulated gloves.
8. Water produced by this washer can cause burns or tears. If skin is hit by sprayed liquid, seek medical attention immediately.
9. Do not alter pressure washer in any manner. If repairs are necessary, contact manufacturer immediately.

If the person receiving this handout will not be the user of the equipment, forward these instructions to the operator.

IF there is any doubt as to the operation or safety in the equipment, DO NOT USE. CALL MANUFACTURER IMMEDIATELY. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH.
